

How do I apply?

Applications for entry to the Doctor of Dental Surgery commencing in 2012 will open in May 2011.

Deadline for domestic and international applications via GMAC – 5pm Friday 10 June 2011

Deadline for direct international applications – Midnight, Friday 24 June 2011

Domestic* applicants

Domestic applicants must apply via the [GMAC Online Admission System](#).

Guaranteed entry for school-leavers to graduate professional entry programs

Domestic applicants eligible to apply as part of the University of Melbourne Guaranteed entry for school-leavers to graduate professional entry programs (<http://cms.unimelb.edu.au/futurestudents/ugrad/apply/scores/guaranteed-entry>) should submit their [application form](#) direct to the Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry and Health Sciences (MDHS) Student Centre by 5pm on Friday 10 June

Graduate Access Melbourne

Some domestic applicants may be eligible to apply for entry as part of the Graduate Access program. Graduate Access Melbourne provides access to applicants whose personal circumstances have had a sustained adverse effect on their academic achievement at undergraduate level or who are members of a specific group known to be under-represented in higher education. Applications for the Graduate Access Program should be submitted direct to the Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry and Health Sciences (MDHS) Student Centre (<http://sc.mdhs.unimelb.edu.au/>) at the same time as the application is submitted via the GMAC Online Admissions System.

GAMSAT

All domestic applicants must have a current score on the Graduate Australian Medical School Admissions Test (GAMSAT). Domestic applicants residing outside of Australia must also have a current GAMSAT, other tests such as the MCAT will not be accepted.

International applicants

International applicants apply either via the GMAC Online Admission System or direct to [International Admissions at the University of Melbourne](#). It is not possible to apply via VTAC. Applications will be accepted online or by mail. You may submit your application direct to the University or through one of our overseas representatives.

Guaranteed entry for school-leavers to graduate professional entry programs

International applicants eligible to apply as part of University of Melbourne Guaranteed entry for school-leavers to graduate professional entry programs (insert hyperlink) must still [apply direct](#) to International Admissions at the University of Melbourne or via GMAC if they have completed GAMSAT.

For applicants applying via the GMAC Online Admission System:

Applicants who have passed subjects listed as equivalent on the pre-requisite equivalence table do not need to submit the Pre-requisite Assessment Notice.

For applicants applying direct to the University:

If you would like to receive advice about your pre-requisite equivalency prior to submitting your application you should complete the Prerequisite Assessment Notice (<http://sc.mdhs.unimelb.edu.au/prerequisites>) and forward it to the MDHS Student Centre by

9 May 2011. You will then receive an assessment notification which you can submit with your application.

GAMSAT

All international applicants residing in Australia at the time of application must sit the GAMSAT. MCAT scores or other test scores cannot be used by these applicants.

International applicants residing outside of Australia may use the Graduate Australian Medical Schools Admission Test (GAMSAT) or any of the following tests: North American MCAT (Medical College Admission Test), or the United States DAT (Dental Admission Test) or the Canadian DAT (Dental Aptitude Test) or the UK GAMSAT (the Graduate Medical School Admissions Test) or the UK BMat (Biomedical Admissions Test).

*Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident, New Zealand citizen. New Zealand permanent residents are not domestic applicants and must apply as an International applicant.
